Scopus is the largest multidisciplinary abstract and citation database of peer-reviewed literature, indexing more than 21,000 peer-reviewed journals and 6.8 million conference papers from over 83,000 worldwide events. Google Scholar is a freely available search engine that searches across a wider range of academic sources. Recent estimates of Google Scholar's content have found that it indexes over 160 million items, including journal articles, book chapters, dissertations, and conference papers.
